



**OSHKOSH 2018 EAA AIRVENTURE WAS JUST THE OVERTURE TO A MAJOR
WORLD WAR I AERO EVENT**

Historic Souther Field was opened on July 4th, 1918 as the only WWI Army Air Service training field in Georgia. One of 32 such fields at that time, it is the only one that is still an operational airport. As one of the few airports in the country that can claim 100 years, Souther Field has established “Historic Souther Field, Inc.”, a non-profit to honor and celebrate the thousands of lives impacted over the last hundred years with exhibits, publications and special events.

The group’s inaugural event, the “Great War Aero Event and Fly-in” is scheduled for October 20-21, 2018. The focus, as the event title suggests, is World War I. We are actively seeking participation of authentic and replica aircraft of that era (1914-18), both flyable and static. In addition, we are looking for appropriate exhibits and exhibit artifacts that might be loaned for display including aircraft engines, vehicles, uniforms, unit histories, weapons, photos and other items.
